

where the real money is. At a \$15 wholesale price it would take 600 copies just to cover printing costs! Obviously, this book wouldn't be a quick way to get rich - broke maybe, but not rich.

Then there is the problem of who owns the rights to the book. Zundel disowned it so I assume it is in the free and clear - assuming it was ever copyrighted in the first place. Do you know if anyone currently claims this book?

Assuming I COULD publish this book would you approve of my using your text? This is all hypothetical, of course, but maybe if it did get published I could "pay" you with 20 copies of the book (\$500 retail value). Would that sound acceptable?

I plan to do further checking to see if I can get a better price on the printing costs, although I doubt if I can cut it by much. But I've got time on my hands so I'll give it a shot.

I'm not familiar with George Dietz. Is he with the NSWRP?

The information you had on Rimland was interesting. Something about her and the "abduction" always seemed strange to me although I couldn't put my finger on exactly what.

I've written to the NSWRP to ask if they have a copy of HITLER WE LOVED but I'm not getting my hopes up.

Dear Eric,

I want to apologize for the delay in replying. My father died not long after I wrote to you and I've been in Ohio at the funeral and trying to take care of family business. My mom decided to sell her house and move to Dunlap, which has had me tied up for weeks driving to and from Ohio.

I contacted the NSWRP as you suggested and they had the Hitler book. I sent \$10.00 and it arrived sometime while I was gone. The book had been described to me as a "coffee table book" which is a large photo book you lay open on a coffee table. What I received was nothing of the sort, it was a small 5.5"x8.5" paperback. The content wasn't what I expected either. It is a hell of a good book, just different than what I thought it would be (all Hitler photos and a brief text). Other than the name and your text my book and the original have nothing in common except the general subject. Mine is no better or worse, just different.

At any rate any plans I had for the book have been indefinitely delayed due to my having to finance the funeral and my mom's moving to Dunlap, both of which all but wiped out my savings. Maybe I can handle it in a year or so. Like yourself, I'm not interested in money, just in getting the book out. I very much appreciate your allowing me to use the text. As soon as I can afford some new ink cartridges I'll print up 2 copies of my book and send you one.

Thanks for pointing out what the last line should be. I fixed it in my copy.

Thanks also for the extra reading material that you sent which I'll check out tonight.

It sounds as though Zundel has made a lot of money and a lot of bad decisions. I believe you are correct in thinking he'll never make it back home, which is one reason I'm hesitant to publish the Hitler book. But Zundel should have been a little more low profile and would have ended up with a lot less grief in his life.

11 OCT 03. Dear Bill: Thank you for your letter of Oct. 8th and the S.A.S.E. I have found the words to part of "The Hitler We Loved & Why", which should end "We Love You, Adolf Hitler." You are welcome to use my words however you wish in a possible republication of the book. I do not know of any existing copies, although George Dietz may still have one or two. His Liberty Bell Publications in Reedy, WV, is now out of business, but you may write him c/o his postal address. I don't know if his box is still open.

If you want to publish any book of the title, using my words or not, please do so. There is no need to worry about copyrights, for I am the author, and Zhdandel disavows the book under oath, although he did not disavow the \$100,000 Cotter bequest therefor, as we know. I know how costly and difficult publishing and marketing such a book is, so I do not wish to receive a penny from you in royalties. I live FOR the cause, not OFF the cause.

Under Zhdandel's previous Jewish dominatrix, all books, including "Mein Kampf" which were not written by "The Zud" were suppressed, especially anything with my name thereon. This procedure has been followed by Zhdandel's present Jewish wife who even suppresses Zhdandel's books, in favor of her own.
