

18 April 05. Dear Tom: It was great to receive your letters of March 25<sup>th</sup> & April 13<sup>th</sup>, with the "war stories" of World War II. The ZOG seems to be in a bit of a time warp with all its undue emphasis on that war, but since that war pretty much drove the last nail into the coffin of the White race, while serving jew interests entirely, it is no wonder that Zionists would celebrate their victory, as long as we continue to pay for such victories, with our lives.
