

11-11-05. Dear Phil: Many thanks for your letter of NOV 8th & the outstanding enclosures! I really enjoyed "Train Wreck of the Week" by Bob Chapman, which is full of current info + his witty analysis & presentation. There seem to be a large number of ZOG-critics, so suppression of the Internet will be an important ZOG objective. ZOG may try the tactics used by the jewsmedia against Father Coughlin, The Radio Priest, in the 1930's, by adopting a policy of 'equal time' so every two-bit bible-banger could have his say, thereby drowning out Coughlin's trenchant arguments for social justice. The jews got their biggest boost from the Pope, as I understand, who forbade Coughlin from airing his views.
