I do not work at my Internet postings, for I view the Internet as a by-product of my normal correspondence with real people, who I send copies which they may post on their own websites, as they wish. I merely do what I can do, within my means. Were it not for the advent of the Internet, my writings would not be published. The Internet is ideal for me, because I do not need subscriptions, nor money for printing up a periodical, which has no guarantee that a growing number of real people would read it & subscribe to it. This is why other publications have gone out of business, for lack of subscribers, now that they can read what they want on the Internet. I agree that my message will go out as long as ZCG deems it ignored, but as soon as it becomes heeded to any degree, the ZOG will shut it down, as I'd expect. As Robert Frens of FAEM correctly noted: "If elections were important, they'd be illegal."
