The idea of social pecking orders may not be a matter of design, but of reality. All populations tend toward the bellshaped curve, according to White man's research. In regard to intelligence, it is determined that there is a middle majority or median. At extreme ends of the curve there are the most & the least intelligent. Intelligence is not learned, it is genetic, so eugenics is relevant so as to move the majority toward the intelligent end of the curve & also reduce the number of least intelligent people in a society. History demonstrates that there is no such thing as 'cheap labor', & White man's technology tends to eliminate labor-intensive economies in which pick & shovel work, galley-slaves, &c. are necessary. Whips & chains are no longer a boss's normal equipment in modern societies, but they were common in European societies of the 19th century. Corporal punishment was quite common in the armies & navies, including the merchant marines of that century, as it had long been before. In former British colonies, whipping is combined with incarceration & hard labor. In former Rhodesia, we had a judge nicknamed "Old Six & Six," for his normal sentence for petty theft was "six months hard labor & six cuts of the cane." Corporal punishment is required for those whom words cannot instruct. The USA reportedly has the largest prison population in the world, not only in terms of percentage, but in absolute numbers. In earlier times, such a population would find useful work as slaves, but with technological advances, they merely go into human warehouses. A poor society cannot sustain such large numbers of consumers, so China has relatively few prisoners, since they are used for medical experiments & provide a growing medical market for organs & body-parts. When I was in Japan, my guide told me that prisons were a fairly recent institution, copied from the White man. Prior to that alien concept, all offenders were killed on the spot, without trial. Of course, if one were upper class, he'd be entitled to commit suicide. Death still is the means deemed best to pay all debts, public & private, so it still functions as legal tender. In traditional Japan, a debtor would promise to pay the amount owed "by the new year, or everyone will have the right to laugh at me." To be laughed at in Japanese society was indeed "a fate worse than death." In Asia it is called 'loss of face.' North Korea inflicts that, most noticeably, upon the stupid Americans of our Zionist Occupation Government (ZOG).

Plato warned that a man with ability was the greatest potential benefit to his society, as well as the greatest potential danger. This does not apply in socially-cohesive societies, in which the good of the community comes first. The USA has never had such a society, which explains our current situation, in which criminals have risen to the top, like scum in a cesspool. This scum is erroneously called 'our elite.' One such is the kosher war criminal Wolfowitz, who practiced the ancient Roman custom of filling his office with his own entourage. The ancient Roman practice, as I understand, was that a public officeholder, such as a magistrate, would bring his own slaves to perform the ancillary work required for the office. The Third Reich sought to incorporate men & women with ability into decision-making positions, but there was an insistence on character, including honesty, leadership & courage. These were the prerequisites for entry into the NAPOLA (National Political Academy) & the Officer Candidate Schools. I saw "Die Fahnenjunker", literally, "Flag Nobility," alias Officer Candidate School. The instructor greets the incoming soldier-students with the crisp words: "We know you have the mental & physical abilities to become officers, but now we must find out if you have the right character." Tests were often taken in the form of actual combat, dubbed "training exercises." Obviously, someone had a wry sense of humor. Fewer than 1 out of 20 were discovered to have any leadership potential, based on Chinese findings about U.S. P.C.W.s in Korea, regardless of the U.S. P.C.W.'s rank. This fact was also recognized by the jew-bolsheviks who ordered: "All smooth-handed Goyim to the wall!" Hitler sought to incorporate such leaders into social positions where they could be most beneficial to society. Were I a leader, my first job would be to find my successor.
