

Hail Eric,
Christian Worch said Germany took a million Poles a hundred years ago. I had not heard of this migration. Apparently there are many skins and neonazis in Poland. Read several books given by a supporter. The one Führer-ex by Ingo Haslebach was interesting. I had to call police to get a crazy Pole thrown out of the house. He was wrecking the place and threatening to kill the other Poles. I noticed the Police station was full of posters telling foreigners to report racist crimes.

I have met a Belorussian who speaks many languages and who is racist. She learned this from living in Ireland among chinks and niggers. However to start a family one needs a certain amount of capital. One supporters is selling his house and another building one for over 250.000 euros. These guys aren't going to risk the wrath of their women on a party that doesn't appear to some extent respectable. One local businessman has three cars while the Poles are paid 320 a week in the kitchen. What are the chances he will donate.

One of the Poles here spent seven years in the German basketball league so I will be able to improve my German. Joined a gym and am training.

No news from Tom Nee. One of the supporters here has freaked on a combination of prescribed medicine and alcohol.

Supporters have to cope with their inner Jews and niggers. I am getting quite a few calls on 0857192898.

I read Suvorov's Icebreaker and it is very convincing. Found it as I usually do on the file sharing network. Emailed a copy to Metzger and the rest of my list.

Officially the population is ten percent foreign now here. Some areas of this town have drug wars. These are all White areas apart from the odd halfcaste kid. You could buy a house for a few thousand euros in one of these places. Very run down and it's possible the Sinn Féin have presences in these areas, the IRA having sold guns to the drug dealers. This is a pattern seen in underclass areas around Ireland. So we have a powerful left wing to fight. At what point the IRA became full of commie ideas is hard to pinpoint. Many of the members always were idiots in that area of politics and let their organisation be used. It's going to take years to build the party I've dreamed of and it's exasperating. It might not be possible. I wonder is it even worth my while and if I should move to Germany or somewhere else.

A pity I can't get the money needed from Tom Nee who has 300,000. He is too demanding. One project we talked about was getting a van as a mobile office. I was talking to a woman who started a group concerned that the foreigners are taking their children's jobs. I don't have the car needed to knit together this little grouplets. Before I can really do anything I will need to find funds. He wants to buy a photocopier as the local copyshops refuse to copy his stuff. He broke off contact with me so I can't help him. He won't even manage to use his own copier or find the recruits he needs with his style and odd leaflets. Shame to see idealism go to waste. I could not afford to run in the election here as the large posters used cost 6 euros each.

It's certainly like crossing the desert setting up a party in these circumstances. Added to that some supporters, afraid of their women, think we should "heal the system". They see the system steal our ideas, as it has done in France and Australia as a positive development. It's debatable. Is the neocon approach to immigration as advocated by Sarkozy and used by Howard something we should hope to create here? This supporter leafleted for a citizenship referendum here. The government stole this idea and held the referendum. This cut down some migration but also the ground from under our feet to an extent. Until we build a party worse is better but I'm dealing with action shy people. All these respectable parties are doomed to failure as the system has ground to retreat. It can retreat all the way back to the kind of nineteenth century states we had where the Jew still had control of racist states. We see these strategic withdrawals by the system.

As they say in 'political science' jargon, it seems that Ireland is "going downhill with a tailwind." As you say, the 'respectable' political parties are telling the timid what they want to hear as they continue to welcome the non-Irish invaders.

My impression of the IRA is that they let themselves be taken over by foreigners &/or traitors with a foreign agenda. Since when is a Nationalist movement also a Comintern agency? I saw that in Rhodesia & I see it here in Usrael. I suppose it will be no different in Ireland, unless something causes the Irish to change their views & behavior. You may be that someone who achieves the something.

Women can act as brakes or as whips to motivate their men. I guess the Irish women have chosen to act as brakes on pro-Irish activism. Too bad! Lesh drink ta that.

In regard to Poles, I recall a Hitler speech in which he said that the German people were looking for "a steady Pole." But when 2 Poles are fighting each other, that is called "a bipolar disorder," to use a clinical expression.
