
Europe's population change 2007-2050

THE MOVEMENT TO SAVE IRELAND



16 June 07. Hail Brian! Many thanks for your letter & enclosures of 8 June 07. I shall copy the M.S.I. flier on demographics for my readers. I'm glad to note that you have a website & a P.O. Box to improve communications. What your flier states should have been stated in the USA before it was founded officially in 1776, but will it be too late for Ireland? Why do so many Irish not consider themselves as Irish, but as interchangeable featherless bipeds; consumption & excretion units, seemingly without a past, a culture & a future as Irish? It is clearly the fault of those put in charge of Irish culture, government & traditions. The Great Whore alias The Church wants quantity above all, so they don't care about Irish. For the Jesus-eaters, 'souls' are all the same, & the more the better, nor does jew money stink in the holy-hoaxers' nostrils. The Irish have great traditions of music, literature & art. They have brought these gems of Irish culture to such places as America, but what will happen when the source of Irish genius is contaminated & likely eliminated by multi-culturalism & genocide? On the other hand, an invader who intended to displace French people & French culture with his own might avoid the learning of French by living in his own colonies, amongst his own people, at French expense, of course, as we can see in the USA et al. Why should anyone learn the language of a dying culture?

I received a chatty letter from Tom Nee, which I enjoyed in one respect: He makes me feel modern. He told me of his ban from photocopy shops because of his pro-Irish items. So far, his communications rely upon face-to-face contacts & laboriously-prepared logo-disks, for which he is unique. I guess this form of transmission would be called "disko-tech." I reflect that technology exists with which to make CDs & DVDs with much less effort & greater message content for those allergic to printed messages.

Your picture of Limerick's Southill area was beautiful in an eerie way. The row houses with spaces in between were rather charming, but the total lack of people on the street made it look like The Deserted Village. The burnt-out cars blocking the thoroughfares made it look like an abandoned war zone.

I'm glad to read that many of your supporters overseas are interested in moving to Ireland. You are certainly in a good position to help them get settled. Perhaps the pro-Irish movement will come from abroad, as well as the anti-Irish invaders, while the native Irish just stand around as idle spectators, or anti-Irish traitors to their Folk. If someone were to depict this grotesque future, which is present-day Ireland, some would say that his crystal ball was in need of repair.

The IRA connection with guns & drugs resembles Third World developments of narco-terrorism. I recommend the old movie, "The Battle of Algiers," in regard to drug-dealers' role in anti-national forces.
