Retired Roman Catholic Cardinal Jean-Marie Lustiger, 80, the longtime archbishop of Paris whose prominence in France, in his church and in Western culture owed much to his faith, his intellect and his Jewish descent, died Sunday. The French newspaper Le Figaro attributed his death to cancer.
