Most Americans missed the party Sunday Times, South Africa 8 OCT 07

THE economic party is winding down and most working Americans never even got near the punch bowl.

The Census Bureau reported on Tuesday that median household income rose 0.7% last year its second annual increase in a row — to \$48 201. The share of households living in poverty fell to 12.3% from 12.6% in 2005.

This seems like welcome news, but a deeper look at the belated improvement in these numbers -- more than five years after the end of the last recession - underscores how gains from economic growth have failed to benefit most of the population.

The median household income last year was still about \$1 000 less than in 2000, before the onset of the last recession. In 2006, 36.5 million Americans were living in poverty — about 5 million more than six years before, when the poverty rate fell to 11.3%

And what is perhaps most disturbing is that it appears this is as good as it's ever going

Sputtering under the weight of the credit crisis and the associated drop in the housing market, the economic expansion that started in 2001 looks as if it might enter the history books with the dubious distinction of being the only sustained expansion on record in which the incomes of typical American households never reached the peak of the pre-

It seems that ordinary working families are going to have to wait - at the very minimum until the next cycle to make up the losses they suffered in this one. There's no guarantee that

they will. Overall, the new data on incomes and poverty mesh consistently with the pattern of the last five years, in which the spoils of the nation's economic growth have flowed almost exclusively to the wealthy and the extremely wealthy, leaving little for everybody else.

Standard measures of inequality did not increase last year, according to the new census data. But over a longer period, the trend becomes crystal clear: the only group for which earnings in 2006 exceeded those of 2000 were the households in the top 5% of the earnings distribution. For everybody else, they were lower.

This stilted distribution of rewards underscores how economic growth alone has been insufficient to provide better living standards for most US families. What is needed are policies to help spread benefits broadly - be it more progressive taxation, or policies to strengthen public education and increase access to affordable healthcare.

Unfortunately, these policies are unlikely to come from the current White House.

EAR-MONGERING, arrogance and bureaucratic bullying. By such tools, Donald Rumsfeld became one of the most powerful, most unpopular and ultimately most unsuccessful Pentagon chiefs in history. Any doubts about that judgment have been removed by the publication this week in the Washington Post of a selection of his "snow-flakes" - the short memos the former defence secretary was wont to fire off daily in scores to his staff. They pestered, they irritated, and on occasion they terrorised their recipients. Together, they give a depressing snapshot of the modus operandi of their boss, as he presided over the debacle in Iraq.

"Keep elevating the threat. Talk about Somalia and the Philippines," Rumsfeld urged in April 2006 as Iraq fell apart and former generals demanded his resignation. "Make the American people realise they are surrounded in the world by violent extremists."

Not least the snow-flakes underline the mendacity inherent in Rumsfeld's style. Whenever pushed into a corner at a Pentagon briefing, he would wriggle free by claiming that he was not involved in a particular decision, that he had not had the time to read an embarrassing article or leaked report. Any mistakes, he implied, were made by underlings. In fact, as the memos prove, he was an obsessive micromanager, who knew everything that was going on.

Most depressing, however, while the man himself has gone, his methods remain. Rumsfeld was forced from his job in November 2006, after the Republican midterm election defeat for which his mismanagement of the war was largely responsible. His successor, Robert Gates, has a low-key, cautious and thoughtful style, far removed from the abrasive Rumsfeld. But the scare-mongering continues. Be it the use of torture or the threat posed by Iran, this White House (still featuring Rumsfeld's ally Dick Cheney) trots out the same justification: America is in mortal peril, and all means are justified.

In other words, as the departed, unlamented master would put it: "Keep elevating the threat." - The
