For the Nation to live Republicanism must perish.

The southern republic was not set up for "humanity". It was set up for Irish people. Devalera's Ireland persecuted protestants in a drive for homogeneity. Protestants were murdered immediately after independence, houses were burnt. They didn't teach that in history class at school when I was a kid because they teach the propaganda of the 26 county state in the schools.

By 1916 the Irish nation was loosing its identity and rapidly being absorbed into britishness. Dubliners were known as "Jacks" for their fervour in greeting Queen Victoria and waving their union jacks when she visited. Pearse's rebellion allowed the tiny nation to cling to existence.

We are not in a position to know what pressures have been brought to bear on, or what bribes paid to ,the political establishment in Ireland ,to effect the radical demographic changes that have descended almost overnight on Ireland, but its well known that they are a very corrupt bunch.

There is an exact parallel between the divide and conquer tactics used by the British imperialists in Ulster and across the world and the tactics of the NWO today and its third world colonisation of European heartlands. Catholicism became a method for assimilating the protestant element in the south and children of mixed couples were raised catholic. There were too many Catholics in the north for the reverse to occur. The "goose choked on the stuffing" to paraphrase Churchill.

People died and were killed so that the south could be an ethnic state for the Irish. Archbishop MacQuaid helped write the constitution. What would he think if he could see Mosques in Ireland? Republicanism seems to have been a target of far left entryists from early on.

Republicans are known for their "love " of the Irish language, but isn't that only a part of the culture? I want the whole culture defended not just a divisive part.

Their love for the language is a bit fake. Obviously things like languages don't exist without peoples. Mass immigration is sweeping the Irish people away. Moore Street used to be famous for the strong Dublin accents of the women of the market. Now they are gone replaced by a cosmopolitan brood.

Exterminated by Cromwell's roundheads or replaced by colonists with the support and collaboration of the Republican traitors ,it's the same result in the end. The Irish are being eliminated from their own country.

Being like the ancient Celts is more important than making sounds from your throat like the ancient Celts.Secondary identities are often used as disguises from behind which primary identities are attacked.

The Irish aesthetic is more important than the Irish language. The Irish language out of the mouths of republicans and members of the political establishment is merely their siren song, a disguise for their defection from the founder's vision. Pearse said an "Ireland not merely free but Gaelic as well".

If he could see Gerry Adams shake hands with Mandela over the bodies of Boer women and children he would surely raise his mauser rifle and plug the two of them right between their eyes.

Actually many Republicans are naive decent people who have been lead down the wrong path by their leadership.

I was talking to a Sinn Feiner and he was shocked by the consequences of immigration but still felt compelled to follow his party line. I predict that their movement will collapse once a serious nationalist group is formed and underway. Their leadership fear their ideology's internal contradictions being exposed and the defection of their membership.

The Loyalists and the Republicans are mutually supporting. Both parasitic elites would collapse if either community found real leadership and started making reasonable demands to the other.

What happens in Britain and America is our business, Ireland needs a healthy Britain. Its in our national interest to see power there in the hands of people like the BNP. Republicanism does not present any intelligent critique of Britain, instead by deliberately acting dumb and dumping a collective guilt on the British people for their countries actions in Ireland over the centuries they effectively prop up that British establishment that is the enemy of both peoples. The cromwellian spirit needs to be driven out.

The Scottish nationalist party is another abomination that pushes internationalism. Even immigration from other European countries can be negative. Albanians are involved with a lot of crime in the UK. Most of the cars in their country were stolen from elsewhere in Europe.Immigration should flow from north to south and from west to east in Europe.The USA should be reopened to unconditional immigration from all European countries. Ireland must be guarded as a homeland. As a strong homogenous cultural centre it can be a beacon to all of Europe. The Balkans need help

to recover from centuries of Turkish occupation.

Republicans will have to choose between their people and their ideology. One or the other will perish.

These two political forces in Ireland must go: SinnFein/Ira and Fianna Failure. I talked to one taxi driver whose brother was still waiting for accommodation after 8 years while the colonist arrives and is instantly accommodated in a brand new house. For a lasting peace in the north there would need to be ideological decommissioning on both sides. Things like Marxist Sinn Fein and the Orange order must vanish. Both sides need to reform their national lives.

There should be self-determination for the Catholics in the north and they should be given their own police force for their own areas. It is in the interests of both peoples to do that. With a normal police force the de-facto policing of Catholic areas by the Provisional IRA could be ended. Take away their power base by giving the people what they want and deserve, of course this would mean ending the marches through the Catholic areas and sacrificing large parts of Ulster.

In return talk of a 32 county republic should end.

You do not even have a 26 county state, your more and more enslaved every day and closer and closer to oblivion as a people.

I don't mind if we have a few fantasists in our future party though, as long as they oppose immigration.

Nation is people not geography.

The obsolete 19th century nationalist ideas are used as a disguise for the internationalism of today.

We can see from Cuba the kind of "Socialist paradise" Gerry wants to turn Ireland into. There are many valid criticisms of Britain. Wanting no part of Ireland connected to rotten multiracial Britain, now that would be a valid point. But we never hear valid points from the Shinners.

Irish nationalism needs to be taken back from these people. The media calls them nationalists and can only get away with that while there are no real nationalist groups. The situation in the north is an injustice to both peoples. Both deserve better. States should coincide with nations. We see the same story elsewhere. Czechoslovakia was a similarly failed conception.

The ideologies of both sides in the north do not bear inspection and would not withstand realistic historical criticism.

Sinn Fein claim to speak for the Irish people one minute and claim the Irish people don't exist the next and that is what Gerry's position on immigration amounts to. We are not free in the south either. The Fianna failures have taken away free speech and free association amongst other things. The Irish people are not free anywhere. They are clearly openly oppressed in the north and more and more openly in the south

"Republican Sinn Fein is abstentionist. It does not recognise the legitimacy of the Six or 26-County States in Ireland, both of which were created by acts of the British parliament in Westminster as a denial of the wishes of the Irish people. Therefore, it does not give voluntary recognition to either jurisdiction.

It stands for the complete separation of Church and State. It believes in the central importance of the Irish language to the Irish identity.

Republican Sinn Féin is internationalist. It has a sense that we all have a common identity as human beings, as members of the great family of peoples. It wishes to play a role in this wider world community on the basis of equality and respect for the rights of others. In particular, it seeks to eliminate the kinds of international trade and international debt that impoverish the peoples of the Third World. "

There is no place in modern Ireland for such ideologies. Europe is marching to its death. Millions are arriving in Europe and the USA from the third world. Amazingly Irish workers are thrown out of the USA but millions of Mexicans are allowed to stay and given amnesties.

It may well be true that the southern and northern states are illegitimate but so too are the republican parties .As Aine Ni Chonaill said "Sinn Fein want Brits out and Africans in".

I don't think powersharing with Sinn Fein is a good idea in the north. I think it's dangerous to see these Marxist's growing in power across the island. Many people in the south dislike them a lot.

The south with its tradition of coalition governments could easily allow the shinners into power there in some form in the not too distant future.

Although I found learning Gaelic at school very boring, I understand now Pearse's reasoning. I remember I constantly struggled with my motivation. Things like the resurrection of dead languages cannot be brought about by compulsion but only by idealistic men and historical needs. The government is dropping the requirements for the Irish language for the police. The language acts as a second border, keeping foreigners out of key jobs. Ireland will become more and more British without this requirement. To bring the language back would require draconian actions like the French committed against the Alsatians after the Second World War and the majority of the Irish people would not be interested.

I do think we need to organise conservative forces to defend the requirements for the Irish language in government jobs .Its interesting when you meet these far left socialists who speak fluent Gaelic. Paradoxical creatures.

Disasters like the Northern Ireland troubles occur when the rights of peoples are not respected. Their rights to self determination and to a state of their own where they can live in homogeneity. Similarly replacement immigration denies the rights of indigenous peoples to determine their own destinies.

Sinn Fein are notorious and brazen liars. Everyone knows that Adams etc are also members of the Provos. The media goes easy on him because ideologically he is within the envelope of the NWO. They only killed after all British serfs, not the holy pets of the liberals.

They pretend their opposition to "racism" has something to do with the experiences of the Irish in Britain. They always try to cloak their Marxist ideology in a veneer of proirishness. It's a common communist method.

America is the legitimate destination for Irish emigrants. If our civilisation was functioning properly Irish people would be able to move there without any fuss. It is rank hypocrisy to tell the Brits to go home while at the same time demanding the right to colonise Britain.

"Sinn Féin's resolute opposition to racism is in the context of the experience by many Irish people of anti-Irish racism. Sinn Féin will campaign vigorously to encourage the Irish Government, and other governments - especially the British Government - to assume their responsibilities for addressing continuing anti-Irish racism in Britain."

Our hospitals are full of foreign staff and the quality of care is rapidly declining but Britain is full of Irish doctors and nurses who had to emigrate there in the 80s. We could easily bring them back.

I myself am not an old time nationalist. I never had the slightest interest in nationalism or politics before the immigration invasion started. I am a pan-western nationalist. I want to have enough of a group to show the flag at nationalist meetings in other countries next year.

I want to see a real party started that will represent the wishes of the people as demonstrated by them in the citizenship referendum last year. We have a mandate from the people and that is the reason for the fear amongst the existing political establishment in Ireland that a real party will arise that will sweep them away. I think there is massive potential for a party in Ireland. Much of the population is still sound. But something has to be done before people become accustomed to the massive change, while the shock is fresh.

People need to see public meeting and examples of defiance before their spirit is beaten out of them.

We need to get enough people to form a nucleus and then have public meetings to build up enough numbers.

We call especially on the Irish Diaspora in the UK, the USA and around the world and all people of European origin residing in the Island of Ireland for assistance.

We want to form a party with the widest variety of members possible, a national front. In the end if we succeed the left wing elements of republicanism will be left by "themselves alone".

The Irish people must become active defenders of western civilisation and all countries and peoples within it.

We must try to end the conflict in the north because it divides people of European origin .The only hope for a future for any European people in the face of genocidal replacement immigration is unity.

Solving Ulster's problems may seem a tall order at the moment and in the beginning we will focus on building an anti-immigration party in the southern state.
