### Jonestown Suicide

Best book written about Rev. Jim Jones and suicide of 900 US citizens in Guyana is by Trinidadbern, British-based Indian journalist, Shiva Haipaul, brother of famous V.S. Haipaul. Shiva's book *Black & White* (Hamish Hamilton Books, London) released in the USA as *Journey to Nowhere: A New World Tragedy* (Penguin Books, Library of Congress Ho. BP 605, P46 H3 1982) is the most in-depth examination of the Jonestown episode ever done.

As 'black' Haipaul obtained much more information from embarrassed fellow Caribbeantypes than was provided to many US-based white reperters who flocked to the area. For example Shiva records full transcripts of tapes Jones made at Jonestown in the months prior to the mass murder. Those were printed in full by the local Guyana newspapers months after the event but as far as I know no one else has included these, preferring to focus solely on the 'mad preacher' angle. The Naipaul's approach is to follow a story for years.

Raised in the Caribbean, both fled to Britain to escape the Intense anti-Indian racism of the newly independent Regro-majority state. They therefore have a peculiar and pleasing perspective on Black-rule very close to white nationalists but as semi-blacks they are allowed entry to countries that reject whites and Westerners, such as Iran during the first years of post-Shab rule (V.S. Haipaul *Among the Believers: an Islamic Journey* London: Andre Deutsche, 1981 Library Congress No. 909, 097 671 NAD.

We recommend their books as, being 'black', they carry more weight with 'uncenverted' whites than those of hard-core white racial nationalists. Raised as British subjects in colonial-era Trinidad, the Naipaul brothers saw themselves as equal to both white and black. So post-independence it came as quite a shock to be discriminated against for jobs, etc by blacks. Excel the theories at white in post-aparthetic South Africa. As a result the brothers field to England where they again felt accepted. Their self-appointed task after their 'exile' was to wander the 'post-colonial'/Third World exposing the conceit and lies of 'black self-rule'. Any South African reading Haipaul books would experience déjà vu.

John Nicholson seems to relish taking some of the driest topics around, and turning them into completely riveting books. His latest book must

have one of the least attractive, most child unfriendly topics of all time: crime and punishment in Australia, from the early penal settlement, to imprisonment in all its awful forms today. Written in a very matter-of-fact, friendly but didactic way (like a firm-minded schoolteacher), this book tells the history of every aspect of the penal system - the ghastly punishments, the horrible prisons, the prisoner-of-war camps - as well as fascinating statistics on who gets locked up. It is not only historic facts that the author imparts, but also very relevant, topical information that really questions the way Australia deals with those who transgress. Soberly illustrated with rather subdued pictures and detailed diagrams, this is not exactly a nice book,
